

✓ Students sought for summer peace course in Hiroshima

Hiroshima City University is seeking students from around the world to participate in an intensive summer course the public institution is to conduct on the theme "Hiroshima and Peace" from July 28 to Aug. 7 on the institution's campus in Asa-Minami Ward, Hiroshima. The all-English program will feature lectures by various researchers from Japan, South Korea, the United States and other nations, on a range of topics ranging from nuclear issues to the Islamic world. On Aug. 6, participants will attend a memorial service to mark the day in 1945 when the city was devastated by an atomic bomb.

Participants will receive three university credits for taking the course, which costs ¥20,000. For foreign participants, including those currently studying in Japan, the university will arrange free accommodation with local families. The deadline for applications is May 1.
