Hiroshima City University International Student Dormitory "Sakura"



1. Purpose

In the Sakura International Dormitory at Hiroshima City University, Japanese and overseas students live together for the purpose of internationalizing the university and developing global professionals. The dormitory aims to develop resolute individuals who have a global perspective and an outstanding aptitude for sympathizing with others, based on their ability to establish personal relationships and acknowledge different value systems.

2. Facility overview

- (1) Building: Reinforced concrete building with 6 floors above ground
- (2) Total floor area: 2,885 m²
- (3) Built in 2018
- (4) Residents' rooms:
 - For long term residents: 16 units [6 rooms and a combined dining room/kitchen per unit]

(One unit consists of 6 private rooms, a kitchen, a living room, a shower room, toilets, and a washroom. The kitchen, living room, shower room, toilets, and washroom are shared by the residents of the unit.)

- * An apartment with 6 private rooms is defined as one unit.
- For short term residents: 2 units[3 shared rooms and a combined dining room/kitchen per unit]


(One unit consists of a 2 person shared room, a 3 person shared room, a 5 person shared room, a kitchen, a living room, a toilet and a washroom. The kitchen, living room, toilet and washroom are shared by the residents of the unit.)

* An apartment with three rooms for 2, 3, and 5 residents is defined as one unit.

^{*}Besides the above-mentioned fees, utility bills (electricity, gas, and water) for private rooms and common spaces must be paid. Utility bills for common spaces are shared by unit residents. If you rent bedding, a rental fee is necessary.
